GRANT FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENTS FOR CITRUS COUNTY SCHOOLS



## Time Sensitive Grants

**Target Youth Soccer Grants** provides support for player registration fees, player and field equipment, training and professional development for volunteer coaches. Any eligible school, government agency, non-profit organization or non-profit regional/local soccer organization within the U.S, serving youth 5 to 18 years old, can apply. A preference will be given to programs serving in-need communities. **Deadline: June 15, 2019 Application**

**Living to Serve Grants** provide an opportunity for FFA chapters and state FFA associations/foundations to seek funding to support various types of service projects through a competitive application process. Applicants must identify a community need that falls into one of four focus areas: community safety; hunger, health and nutrition; environmental responsibility; or community engagement. Provides up to \$3,000 to support a service-learning project that spans an entire school year. **Deadline: June 17, 2019 Application**

**Classics for Kids Foundation** works to empower young people to shape positive futures through music and to build and strengthen sustainable stringed instrument music programs. To support this goal, this program will provide matching awards for the purchase of high-quality stringed instruments for use by children in grades K-12. **Deadline: March 31, 2019, June 30, 2019, September 30 and December 31, 2019 Application**

**Educators for Equity Grants** offer Educators that strive to foster academic growth among underserved students, including those that are economically disadvantaged and English language learners, Pre-K-12. Proposed programs should be equity-focused, evidence-based, culturally relevant to students served, and explicitly designed to improve academic opportunities and outcomes. Awards are up to \$10,000 **Deadline: June 30, 2019 Application**

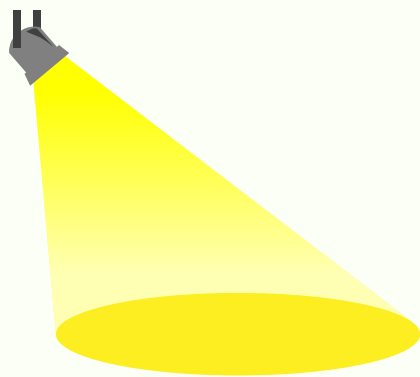
**Karma for Cara Community Service Youth Microgrants** funds community service projects created by students 18 years of age and under. Provides up to \$1,000. **Deadline: April 1, July 1, October 1st and January 1st. Application**

**Baseball Tomorrow Fund (BTF)** provides funding for programs, fields, coaches' training, and the purchase of uniforms and equipment to encourage and maintain youth participation in the game. The funds are intended to finance a new program, expand or improve an existing program, undertake a new collaborative effort, or obtain facilities or equipment. Award ceiling not specified; the average grant amount is approximately \$40,000. **Deadline: April 1, July 1, October 1st and January 1st. Application**

**NEA Foundation Learning and Leadership Grants** program provides support to teachers, public education support professionals, and/or faculty for high-quality professional development experiences such as summer institutes or action research; or grants to groups in support of collegial study, including study groups, action research, lesson study, or mentoring experiences for faculty or staff new to an assignment. Grant amounts are \$2,000 for individuals; \$5,000 for groups. **Deadline: June 1st and October 15th, 2019 and February 1st, 2020 Application**

**James Patterson and Scholastic Book Clubs Giveaway for Classroom Libraries** offers teachers of Pre-K - 12th grade students a way to increase their classroom library. Grant amounts range from \$250 and 250 Bonus Points (teachers with 4+ years teaching) to \$500 and 500 Bonus Points (teachers with 0-3 years teaching). **Deadline: July 31st, 2019 Application**

**Dr. Scholl Foundation Grants** provide funding in the area of education. Grant amounts range from \$5,000 - \$25,000. **Deadline: Window open October 1st - March 1st at 4:00 pm** Only one application can be accepted from an institution per grant year. **Application**
