

Citrus County Schools is pleased to announce our ESOL endorsement course schedule. Courses will be offered through Edivate (formerly PD360) and are free of charge in 2018-19.

Each course is 60 hours which is equivalent to a 3-semester hour college course. We do not recommend taking more than one course at a time. Contact Leia Swiggett (swiggettl@citrus.k12.fl.us) or see http://esol.citrusschools.org/ for more information.

ESOL Endorsed: Teachers must take domains 1-5 (300 hours).

ESOL Certified: Teachers must take 120 hours of ESOL coursework and pass the ESOL certification exam. Teachers pay for this exam and are reimbursed for a passing score.

ELA/Reading Teachers: Require the endorsement or certification to meet state compliance.

Content Area Teachers, Guidance Counselors, and Administrators: Require 60 hours of coursework to meet state compliance.

Elective teachers, Pre-K teachers, and speech pathologists: Require 18 hours of coursework to meet state compliance.
