

### **Reemployment/Renewed Membership after July 1, 2010**

Members with a retirement date of July 1, 2010 or after must stay terminated for 6 months before returning to work. There is an option to return to work after the 6 months but the member would have to suspend their retirement benefit for the remaining months (7-12 months). There are no exceptions to this rule.

If a member decides to return to work in an FRS covered position after being retired for the first 12 months, they would still continue to receive their monthly benefit check.

Anyone who retires after July 1, 2010 and takes distribution from his or her retirement will not be eligible for renewed membership in the Florida Retirement System. To be eligible to participate in a 2<sup>nd</sup> retirement with the FRS you must be initially reemployed in an FRS covered position no later than June 30, 2010.
