All current English Language Learners (ELL) and specified former ELLs in grades K-12.

Date

Administered in March/April of each school year.

Description

The CELLA is a criterion-referenced test administered to measure students' proficiency and gains in English in four domains: reading, writing, listening, and speaking.

Results

The results of CELLA will be used in federal accountability procedures, as required by Title III of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB) to report district performance on the Annual Measureable Achievement Objectives (AMA0s).
