

Florida Assessments for Instruction in Reading (FAIR)

Grades/Students

All students grades K-3 and select students grades 4-12.

Date

Administered three times a year.

Description

The Florida Assessments for Instruction in Reading (FAIR) is a screening, diagnostic and ongoing progress monitoring assessment that measures phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary and comprehension. In grades K-2 the assessment is administered individually to students. In grades 3- 12 the assessments are computer-adaptive and delivered on Internet-connected computers.

Results

Results are immediately available to teachers and schools for targeting instruction through the Progress Monitoring and Reporting Network (PMRN). Teachers may use results to group students for differentiated instruction through intervention.

Basis of Test

Required for all kindergarten students as part of the Florida Kindergarten Readiness Screener (FLKRS), for all students in grades 1-3, and for all students scoring in FCAT Levels 1 and 2 in grades 4-12.
